## Back in the USA

Well, we made it back to the United States, in case you haven't heard. We are back until the end of July for our 3 month home assignment. The purpose of our time here is to connect with friends, family, and supporters as well as raise support for our next term. We also just happened to be back in the US for the birth of our baby boy Nathan (read the story below!). While we are here, we are staying with Janell's family, visiting our friends, and sharing what God is doing in Mexico with various churches. Dennis also used some of this time to continue working on his Master's degree with Columbia Biblical Seminary. It has hardly been a vacation.

We arrived in the USA at the Miami airport on March 28. We have been staying in the Tampa Bay area, and we have visited many of our supporting churches, including New Hope, Grace Bible, and Spirit Life Church.

## Nathan is here!

Around 8 in the morning on April 25, Janell said to me, "I think we need to call the doctor." I didn't think it would be the day that Nathan would arrive (he wasn't due until May 14). The doctor told us to go to the office or the hospital. We chose the office. When we got there, they told us to go to the hospital because it wouldn't be long. Later that day, at 3:54 p.m., we had our new baby boy, Nathan Christopher. He weighed 6 pounds, 4 ounces, and was 20 inches long.

Since that day, it has been great to see him grow and develop. We love being parents, and we are excited about every little thing he does, like most new parents are! Nathan is perfectly healthy, and since his birth, he has been steadily packing on the pounds.

We are now working on getting all of the necessary paperwork for Nathan's passport and visa to go to Mexico with us in July. We are looking forward to having him with us and showing him off to all of our friends in Mexico.

It has been good to eat some American food from our favorite restaurants, watch movies without subtitles, and speak in English. These things are important for us to recharge our batteries so we can return to Mexico refreshed for the next 2 year term.

We will be in the US until the end of July, but Dennis will be going to Mexico at the beginning of July to lead a short term team from Naples that will be ministering in Mexico City. We'd love to get together with you while we are in town. If you have time, and want to see us, please contact us. We'd love to spend time with you.

If you live near Dunedin, we'll be having a dessert party at New Hope Community Church on June 27 at 7 pm. You're invited to hear what God is doing in Mexico. We'd love to have you. Please RSVP using the information on the enclosed invitation.

It's amazing how many things a little baby needs! Sometimes it is hard just to go to the store, so we know it is going to be a trying time when we move back to Mexico with him! Also pray for our families as they have already grown to love him and will miss him (and us) when we leave. J

We have been so blessed in the last year and a half. God has done many amazing things that make us say, "Wow!"

Some of those things are: We learned Spanish (believe it or not!). We started the first youth ministry seminary training program in Latin America. We have been contacted by people from Ecuador, Guatemala, El Salvador, and Cuba about the program at the seminary. We have begun a model youth ministry in a local church. We have networked with the Mexican national Baptist Convention, and we are working closely with them on national youth ministry strategies. We have made many friends, both with missionaries and nationals. We have been provided with inexpensive housing opportunities. Nathan arrived with good health. Our support has been steady. God has provided all we need...and more. That is more than enough to cause us to say, "Wow...Amazing!"

## Future Schedule

On **July 5-15**, Dennis will be going back to Mexico with a local church youth group from First Baptist Church in Naples, Florida, for a ministry trip. During the trip, they will be ministering with local churches to reach young people in the community. Please pray for this travel and ministry.

There will be another short term trip at the **end of July** led by Troy Temple. They will be working with Huberto Perez, a youth ministry student at the seminary and youth pastor of Renovation Church. We will be returning to Mexico for the end of this trip probably on **July 27**.

The new school year at the seminary begins **August 23**. Dennis will be teaching *Principles of Youth Ministry* to the first year students as well as *Foundations of Youth Ministry* for the second year youth ministry students. We will also be picking up the youth ministry at Dios Es Amor, our local church youth ministry in which Rigo and Israel, both seminary students, have been working this summer.

*That our current youth ministry students will be diligent in their studies and ministries in the coming year.*

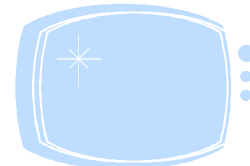
*That we can get all of the required paperwork on time for Nathan to enter Mexico.*
